

Neuro Masters 2025 Festival Regulations

1. General Provisions

- 1.1. **Neuro Masters** is the first international film festival in Russia showcasing films created using artificial intelligence technologies. It will take place in 2025 in an online/offline format.
- 1.2. The goal of the festival is to demonstrate an innovative approach to the use of AI in art and to support creative creators who apply modern technologies.
- 1.3. **Organizer:** the Neuro Masters team and the digital agency Nectarin.
- 1.4. Participation in the festival is free for all participants.

2. Categories and Awards

2.1. Festival categories:

- Best Film
- Best Promo Film
- Best Music Film
- Best Social Film
- Best Comedy Film

2.2. Three prizes will be awarded in each category:

- Gold
- Silver
- Bronze

2.3. The **Grand Prix** will be awarded to the best work across all categories.

3. Participation Conditions

- 3.1. Videos created using AI technologies, including video generation, music, scriptwriting, animation, and speech synthesis, are eligible for submission.
- 3.2. Each participant may submit an unlimited number of entries.
- 3.3. The same work can be submitted to multiple categories.
- 3.4. Applications must be submitted via the official festival website.

4. Festival Stages

4.1. **Preparation Stage:**

- Submission period: until April 1, 2025.

4.2. **Evaluation Stage:**

- Preliminary online judging will begin in April 2025.
- The final award ceremony will take place in 6 June 2025.

4.3. The Award Ceremony Program, which will take place on June 6 at the KARO 11 October cinema (Russia, Moscow, 24 New Arbat Street), includes:

1. Screening of Finalist and Winning Films of the Festival
 2. Masterclasses by Jury Members
 3. AI Achievements Exhibition
 4. Prize Awarding Ceremony
 5. Entertainment Program
 6. Buffet Reception
- 4.4. The Organizing Committee may make changes to the Festival dates.

5. Video Requirements

- 5.1. Videos containing excessive violence, pornography, hate speech, or political propaganda will not be accepted.
- 5.2. Videos must be in Full HD format or higher and have a duration of 10 seconds to 15 minutes.
- 5.3. Non-English videos with voice-over or dialogues must include English subtitles.
- 5.4. All images, characters, and story elements in the film must have the necessary copyright permissions.
- 5.5. Preview image of the film (Google Drive link, PNG or JPG format, 16:9 aspect ratio, minimum size: 1280x720, maximum: 1600x900, file size up to 10 MB).
- 5.6. The festival organizing committee reserves the right to reject any submission without explanation.

6. Jury and Evaluation Criteria

- 6.1. The jury will include leading international experts in artificial intelligence and video production.
- 6.2. Evaluation criteria:
 - Quality of execution
 - Originality of the idea
 - Innovative use of AI technologies

7. Transparency and Fairness of the Competition

- 7.1. Participants with clear ties to jury members (family, friendly, or romantic relationships) are not eligible for awards.
- 7.2. All jury decisions are final and cannot be appealed.

8. Principles of the Festival

- 8.1. The festival adheres to a principle of neutrality, excluding discussions of political topics and conflicts.
- 8.2. The primary focus is on art and innovation.

9. Final Provisions

- 9.1. The organizers reserve the right to amend the regulations before the submission deadline.
- 9.2. Participation in the festival implies acceptance of these regulations.
- 9.3. Neuro Masters Festival may use submitted works, as well as the author's name and contact information, at its discretion.
